History

- Established in 1991 by Parkway Marina.
- Since 2001, SVFC has organized the event and provided manpower to handle the growing popularity of the event.
- Since 2005, the National Guard & Virginia Defense Force has assisted the SVFC with additional man-power and event activities.

Fireworks Display

- Supplied by Zambelli International, which supplies major displays through-out the world
- Approximately 20 min show averaging about 1.5 shells a second
- What sets this display apart from other major displays is the setting: the reflection off the lake and the reverberation off the mountains significantly amplifies the display. There's nothing else like it.

Attendance

- Total observers number in the tens of thousands
- 2500-3500 attend the event at the marina
- 3000-3500 boats observe from the water
- Unknown numbers watch the event from other locations
